# Minimum Eligibility Criteria for Admission

## THREE YEAR (HONOURS / GENERAL) DEGREE COURSE

This course is meant for those who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or an equivalent examination. Candidates fulfilling the following marks criteria may apply for admission provided they have passed the H.S. or equivalent examination not earlier than the year just preceding the year in which admission is sought. 5% marks are deducted from the aggregate for the purpose of determining eligibility and preparing merit list for candidates whom have not passed H.S. or equivalent examination in the current year.

	Geology	Minimum 60% marks in aggregate with an average of 60% marks in 3 elective subjects, with at least 50% marks in Mathematics and Physics/Chemistry
B.Com. Honours	Accountancy	Minimum 55% marks in aggregate & subject OR, Minimum 55% marks in aggregate & 55% marks in Mathematics (for candidates coming from science stream)
General	B.A.	Minimum 40% marks in aggregate
	B.Sc. Pure	Minimum 40% marks in aggregate with Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics combinations
	B.Sc. Bio.	Minimum 40% marks in aggregate with Biology
	B.Com.	Minimum 40% marks in aggregate

Physically handicapped candidates can not apply for **GEOLGY** Honours

# Instruction for filling up the Application Form

01. One applicant can fill up a maximum of three forms (two for Honours subjects and one for General Course, supplied with each prospectus) on the basis of minimum marks (subject wise) mentioned in the College Prospectus. Each Application should accompany a set of attested copies of relevant documents.
02. Applicants are also required to return the form or forms over the counter with the indication of "X" in case those are not filled in on account of either lack of qualifying marks or absence of interest in the subject other than the one for which one has exercised option.
03. **On the RECEIPT the candidate should clearly mention his/her name, and the subjects and categories of forms in which he/she has applied.**
04. **For Downloaded Forms Original Mark sheet & Admit Card must be produced at the time of submission.**

## CALCULATION OF AGGREGATE

Following instruction issued by the University of Burdwan vide Circular No. RC/PERM/ADM/539 dated 08.05.07, the formula for calculation of aggregate for admission to the 1<sup>st</sup> year courses at UG level (Session 2011-2012) will be:

$$\text{Aggregate} = \text{Language 1} + \text{Language 2} + \text{Sum of best 3 electives out of 4}$$

### **Please Note -**

- ❖ *Marks secured by WBCHSE candidates in Environmental Studies will not be counted for calculating aggregate. However, marks secured in Environmental Studies by non-WBCHSE candidates may be counted for calculating aggregate if that marks comes within the best three Electives.*
- ❖ *If there is just one language, aggregate will have to be calculated with the single language and four best Electives. If there are only four Electives apart from the language, all the Four Electives should be considered for calculating aggregate.*

- (a) Candidates who have passed (10+2) Final Examination conducted by NOS/ IGNOU/ Rabindra Mukta Vidyalaya/NETAJI SUBHAS OPEN UNIVERSITY with at least five subjects of 100 marks each including at least one language subject (English or Bengali) and three conventional subjects will be considered for admission in the 1<sup>st</sup> year if found eligible.
- (b) 5% marks has to be deducted from the aggregate & subject for the candidates of previous year (passed in the year 2010). No candidate prior to 2010 will be entertained.
- (c) In case of the candidates who passed HS Examination (Old Pattern/Old-Syllabus of WBCHSE) in 2011, aggregate calculation should be made by taking marks obtained in two language subjects and best of the three elective subjects out of four subjects (including additional subject). This aggregate has to be converted to 500 from 1000 and the subject marks has to be converted to 100 from 200.

## CALCULATION OF GRAND TOTAL

- **Grand Total can be obtained by adding the Aggregate with the score of the opted subject in which the applicant is willing to get admission as Honours Subject (Except Geology).**
- **For Geology Honours, Grand total can be calculated by adding the Aggregate, Marks scored in Mathematics and Marks scored in best 2 electives (excluding languages and mathematics).**
