Hooghly Mohsin College is presently one of the oldest Govt colleges in the state of West Bengal. It was established in the year 1836. It is the heritage institute of 176 years. It is the Alma Mater of many Bengal luminaries like Bankim Chandra Chattopadhyay (Novelist), Dwijendra Lal Roy (Poet), Jyotish Chandra Ghosh (Freedom Fighter), Kanailal Dutta (Freedom Fighter), Shyamal Mitra (Singer), Satinath Mukhopadhyay (Singer), Upendra Nath Bhramachari (Scientist) and many more. The college has 18 departments including 6 post-graduate depts. The college publishes a peer-reviewed journal with ISSN on regular basis. The college has been accredited by NAAC in the year 2007 and was awarded B++ scoring 81.5%. The college has been recognized as CPE (College with Potential for Excellence) by UGC. IQAC of the college was constituted on July 9, 2007 to monitor the quality standard of academic activities of the college. 7. Physiology dept initiated for a workshop with DBT STAR College financial support and also proposed to organize a state level work.
8. Zoology dept initiated a move to organize a state level seminar.
9. Extension and value added programmes were proposed to organize in this academic year.
